To improve researching, public speaking, debating and writing skills in addition to critical thinking, teamwork and leadership abilities.




To differentiate between the parliament and the UN, while distinguishing power struggle from diplomacy.



REGISTRATION

All registrations are accepted on a **first come & first serve** basis. Once the maximum capacity is reached, the subsequent applicants will be placed in the waiting list.

VISA

IMUN will provide the necessary documents to support your visa application on request but not responsible for your Visa into indonesia. It is your responsibility to secure the necessary documents to enter Indonesia.

CANCELLATION POLICY

If the event is cancelled by the organizer, you will receive a full refund (100%). If you cancel your participation in the event for any reason, you receive no refunds. We cannot however compensate you for airfare or travel costs incurred. In the unlikely event that the event is cancelled due to weather, natural disaster, or political upheaval, we cannot guarantee a refund – it will be depending on receiving a refund from the venue / tour operator we work with.
